

## **Training Agreement**

### **The Unified Protocol Institute & Denis Moskovchenko (“the trainer”)**

Denis Moskovchenko is qualified to conduct Levels I, II, and III training regarding the Unified Protocol (UP), and is free to advertise his services within Russia and surrounding European countries.

The trainer will identify clients independent of the UPI and will determine training fees for each training offering according to standard rates within the region. The UPI may refer clients to the trainer as appropriate.

The trainer is authorized to indicate that the training offerings provided are “sponsored by the UPI,” but cannot use any language that suggests the UPI is directly involved in the training, or that they are responsible for the training content (e.g. the trainer cannot state the training will be conducted “with,” “through,” or “in collaboration with” the UPI). All training responsibilities and obligations are maintained solely by the trainer.

The UPI retains all rights, title, and interest in and to any materials created by the UPI for training purposes (e.g., slides, adherence criteria, etc.). If the trainer produces additional training materials (e.g., supplementary handouts, slides designed for specific trainings, adherence criteria designed for specific trainings, etc.), these materials will be owned by the trainer. All materials are required to have the word “Unified” in their title. Additionally, all training materials must cite the UP and acknowledge any work contributed by the UPI.

If the trainer produces materials specifically for an organization, those materials will be owned by the agency for whom they were produced. Any materials produced for a specific agency are required to have the word “Unified” in their title. Additionally, these materials must acknowledge the role of the UPI in the creation/preparation of these materials in perpetuity.

The trainer will complete a “Completed External UP” form, provided by the UPI, upon the completion of training.

Trainees will pay the trainer directly for all services stipulated in their agreement. Upon receipt of the funds the trainer will then pay the UPI 10%. The trainer will notify the UPI that payment has been made via email at the time of payment to ensure the UPI can track it and confirm receipt.

The UPI will administer training documents and update the UPI website as appropriate to reflect completion of training by trainees within two weeks of the receipt of payment.
